The Geology Department at Middlebury College invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of Assistant Professor that will begin in September, 2010. We desire an individual with expertise in the interactions between climate, tectonics and Earth surface processes. The successful applicant will teach both introductory and upper-level undergraduate courses, advise undergraduate research, and develop a research program in their area of expertise. The department runs a field-oriented program complemented by a wide array of instrumental capabilities located in a new state-of-the-art science facility. The Geology major at Middlebury includes a year-long required senior thesis; some of these theses are published as papers co-authored by the student and their faculty mentor(s).
